Your Management Committee and advisors are now focussed on providing responses to the evidence that has been presented and once that is done we will turn our attention to final preparations for the 18 June Hearing.

Your presence at the Hearing is very important. We want to show the Waitangi Tribunal the face of the Mangatu whanau and our commitment, by our presence, to getting back the land that we were forced to sell in 1961.

Te Poho o Rawiri marae is large and will easily accommodate over 200 people. June can be cold, so we have requested that adequate heating be provided in the whareniui. We recommend however that you should still dress warmly. Morning and afternoon tea, and a light lunch will be provided.

For our owners living in Gisborne, please call into the office at the end of each Hearing day for petrol vouchers to cover your travel costs. For those from out of town, we can provide some assistance for your travel costs to and from the Hearing, as well as for accommodation and meals.
